



PLACEMENT

The nursing graduates from 2023, including both MSc and BSc nursing students. These graduates are associated with various nursing colleges, universities, and hospitals across India.

For MSc Nursing, students have completed their degrees and are employed as nursing officers, tutors, or faculty members at reputed institutions in abroad like Canada, UK, Norway, Newzland etc. Prominent MSc Nursing graduates are affiliated with well-known colleges like KINS, KIIT University, Sum Nursing College, Sri Sri University, Prativa Devi College of Nursing, and others in Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Bangalore, Delhi, Mumbai and West Bengal.
